As pastor Cheng was praying for Yapao, he started to cry profusely so that Pastor Cheng had to stop praying and just let Yapao cry out to the Lord.

After Yapao calmed down. Pastor Cheng asked him why he cried. Yapao shared that during the prayer, he thought about the things he had done wrong, the sins he had committed and then to hear that Jesus still loves him was so overwhelming. He just needed to cry in thankfulness to the Lord for his grace and mercy. It is true as the Lord says, *“Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered”* by the blood of Jesus Christ. Yapao was also baptized that day. He is now a newborn child of God. We ask that you keep Yapao in your prayers.
